At 1:03pm, Nina Gage opened the meeting. Brief introductions were made.

At 1:11pm, Sarah Isham moved to approve minutes from 9/21/2022, Joan Goldstein seconded. Ali Kosiba, Paul Frederick and Colleen Goodridge abstained due to absence from September 21st meeting. All were in favor.

Liz Gleason gave a programmatic update, suggesting that she meet with each board member over the course of 6 months to hear everyone's thoughts on the future of this program. She also let the committee members know about two upcoming VHCB events.

Liz then introduced the grant review process. This review committee's role is to provide funding recommendations to the VHCB board chair, David Marvin. The VHCB board chair must review and finalize funding recommendations.

Nina Gage called for a motion to approve the agenda. Joan Goldstein moved to approve the agenda, Ashlyn Bristle seconded. All in favor.

Nina Gage called for public comment at 1:24pm. No public comment was made.

At 1:24pm, Joan Goldstein made a motion to enter executive session to review applications. Jenna Koloski seconded the motion. All were in favor.

At 3:36pm, Nina Gage ended executive session.

At 3:36pm, Isaac Bissell motioned to approve the slate, Sarah Isham seconded. All were in favor. The slate in the table below was approved, with a funding total of \$142,559.59 awarded to 16 farm and forest businesses.
